SPANISH QUESTION WORDS

We use question words to ask for specific information.
Choose the right one depending on **what you want to know**.

1

WHAT?
QUÉ



We use it to ask about things, information or activities.

EXAMPLE

¿Qué estudias?
What do you study?

2

WHO?
QUIÉN



We use it to ask about a person or people.

EXAMPLE

¿Quién es Ana?
Who is Ana?

3

WHERE?
DÓNDE



We use it to ask about a place or location.

EXAMPLE

¿Dónde vives?
Where do you live?

4

WHEN?
CUÁNDO



We use it to ask about time, dates or moments.

EXAMPLE

¿Cuándo tienes clase?
When do you have class?

5

HOW?
CÓMO



We use it to ask about manner, way or state.

EXAMPLE

¿Cómo estás?
How are you?

6

HOW MUCH / MANY?
CUÁNTO/A/OS/AS



We use it to ask about quantity or amount.

EXAMPLE

¿Cuántos años tienes?
How old are you?

WHY?
POR QUÉ



We use it to ask about reason or cause.

EXAMPLE

¿Por qué estudias español?
Why do you study Spanish?

QUICK TIPS



START AND END
Questions in Spanish start with **¿** and end with **?**

¿Hablas español?



ACCENT MARKS
Question words usually have an accent.

qué, quién, dónde...



THINK FIRST
Think about the information you want before choosing.

person, place, time...



THEN ASK!
Use the right word to make your question clear and natural.

¿Dónde vives?

IN SHORT

2 WHO? → **QUIÉN**

3 WHERE? → **DÓNDE**
